RE: Updated Covid Protocol Procedures

DEAR MBA MEMBERS AND GUESTS:

We thank you for the confidence you've placed in us and welcome to our Conference Center!

You will notice various changes in the way our Conference Center looks as well as new practices and protocols. Each of these changes are here for your safety, while providing a welcoming environment to share information and learn from one another. Our goal is to collaboratively ensure you feel safe and secure. As things continue evolve, we will adjust this document and our practices accordingly.

Here are some things we have implemented to help keep our Conference Center safe and to support you while you are with us:

- If vaccinated, a mask is no longer required. If you need one and do not have one when you arrive, we will provide you with one.
- We continue to encourage everyone to practice social distancing, staying at least six (6) feet apart at all times while in the Conference Center.
- Access to hand sanitizer throughout the facility and plenty of soap in the dispensers in the restrooms.
- Staggered starting, ending times and breaks for those using the facility.
- More frequent cleaning and sanitizing.

We are also asking you to help keep our Conference Center safe by doing the following:

- Please do not come to the class or a meeting if you feel sick.
- If you begin to feel sick, please be sure to let the instructor or an MBA representative know that you are leaving and why.
- If you test positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of attending a class, please notify the Association as soon as practicable to assist with contact tracing. A close contact would be someone who was less than 6 feet away from infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period (regardless of whether masks were worn or not). An infected person can spread COVID-19 starting 2 days before symptoms began (or two days before a test if a person does not have symptoms).
- Please continue to practice social distancing while using the restrooms.
- Wash your hands often, and for the recommended 20 seconds.
- Once you leave for the day, a professional cleaning crew has been hired to wipe down your area along with other common areas, counter tops and door handles throughout the Conference Center.
- Speak with your instructor or any member of the MBA staff if you have questions or concerns.
